Morning Arrival to School – **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

If you are participating in a sport or activity at Parkland High School you need to take the **PHS Shuttle bus is #122**. You should be dismissed at **2:23pm**

REMINDER: All students must present their ID in the cafeteria to get breakfast and lunch. Make sure that you have your ID on you every time you go to the cafeteria.

Any student that does not have or lost their ID can get a new ID by stopping in the Main Office.
