Dear Parents:

In our efforts to keep you informed with important matters at Springhouse Middle School, we want you to be aware that there are some students in your child's class who have serious peanut/nut allergies. A child with a serious peanut allergy can suffer a reaction merely by touching a peanut-containing food. Therefore, we are putting the following safety guidelines into effect:

- Please do not send any peanuts, peanut butter, other nuts, or food containing peanuts, peanut butter, or other nuts to be eaten as snacks in the classroom. These items cannot be distributed in the classroom due to safety concerns. It is fine to send these products for lunch, which is eaten in the cafeteria.
- Please stay in accordance with the new Parkland School District Wellness Policy. We will try to keep the food at holiday celebrations to a minimum. As with birthday parties, we must be extremely careful about the ingredients in all of the food items. Please do not enclose candy or other food treats with holiday cards.
- If students are bringing food items into the classroom that they will be sharing with others, the food must be pre-packaged and contain a label with the contents and nutritional facts.

Middle school students typically have a better understanding of their allergies and the precautions that need to be taken. However, your assistance in maintaining a safe environment is appreciated. This is a learning process for all of us, but we trust that you understand how deeply important it is to respect and adhere to these guidelines. If throughout the course of the year you have any questions or concerns about food-allergy-related issues, please do not hesitate to contact us.

# **After School Bus Information for Springhouse**

The following information should be helpful for students using the after school shuttle buses and the late activity bus shuttle.

# Shuttle Buses to OMS and PHS

1. If you are participating in an activity after school that is at Orefield Middle School or Parkland High School, you need to take the after school shuttle buses.

2. If you are going to OMS, it is your responsibility to let your teacher know that you need to be dismissed at 2:35 so you can catch the 2:40 shuttle bus to OMS. This bus is located at the end slot (#0) in the bus loading area and leaves promptly at 2:40.

3. If you are going to Parkland High School, you do not need to be dismissed early. The high school shuttle bus is also located in the end slot (#0) in the bus area and leaves at approximately 2:45 after the regular buses leave.

## Late Activity Bus

1. The Late Activity Bus Shuttle leaves Springhouse promptly at 4:20. This bus takes you to Parkland High School where you will board the appropriate Late Activity Bus, depending on your address. This bus leaves the high school at 4:35.

2. All you need to know is your regular bus stop. It is very important for you to give the correct bus stop information to the bus driver when entering the bus. The driver creates the bus route from the stops they receive from the students.

3. Please note that the Late Activity Bus Run is considered an "Express Run" and does not go to every stop in the district. The drivers do their best to get you as close to your regular stop as possible.

4. We cannot guarantee that you will be home at the same time every day due to the fact that these runs vary from day to day.

Please Note: The shuttle buses cannot return to Springhouse for students who miss the bus. It is your responsibility to be on the bus at the appropriate time.
