COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course focuses on using algebraic concepts to solve problems. Topics include solving and graphing linear equations and inequalities, systems of equations and inequalities, rational expressions and equations, polynomials, factoring and radical expressions. This class will prepare students for both the 8th grade PSSA, as well as the Algebra I Keystone Exam.
